

## Plans Relationship Summary – Summer Village of Burnstick Lake

The Summer Village of Burnstick Lake has the following plans:

- ICF Plan
- MDP Plan
- Land Use Bylaw

### **ICF Plan:**

The Summer Village shares a common boundary with Clearwater County. The ICF makes general statements of understanding or intent how the 2 municipalities will work together strategically and regionally. This plan serves to be a master agreement from which a number of subsequent agreements and plans flow.

Some highlights and shared services include road maintenance, snow and ice control, emergency management, fire services, recreation, and weed and pest control.

This plan is the predominant plan in the hierarchy of plans as per the MGA.

### **IDP Plan:**

The Summer Village and Clearwater County received an exemption from AB Municipal Affairs as both Clearwater County and the Summer Village have a common boundary composed entirely of provincial Crown land.

### **MDP Plan:**

The MDP Plan is the next plan in the hierarchy of plans required under the MGA. It follows and draws from the vision and statements within the ICF plan. The MDP is the backbone of the Summer Village's development strategy. It describes what the community wishes to be in the future and, together with the Land Use Bylaw (LUB), provides current and future landowners and residents with a vision and guide to future development.

### **Land Use Bylaw:**

The Land Use Bylaw (LUB) establishes rules and regulations to achieve the orderly and economic development of land in each district (zone) as well as the process of making decisions for development permit applications. The bylaw must also follow adopted statutory plans, the MGA as well as other provincial and federal legislation.
