LAND USE BYLAW REVIEW

The Land Use Bylaw is being updated in 2023.

The purpose of this bylaw is to regulate the use and development of land and buildings within the Summer Village of Burnstick Lake to achieve the orderly, economical and beneficial development of land, and to maintain and improve the quality of the physical environment

The new Land Use Bylaw will ensure the policies from the Municipal Development Plan are implemented. The new Land Use Bylaw will replace the current bylaw that was completed in 1994.

Watch for opportunities to give input and feedback on the new Land Use Bylaw as it is developed throughout the spring and summer.
